Processing and preparation for storage would include heat pressing products according to quality requirements and carrying out necessary sanitation tasks to mitigate the risk of product contamination.

As a 4th Class Power Engineer, you would also be responsible for the operation, maintenance, renovation and repair of our east-side boiler systems and related equipment and, as required, provide support for our westside location. You would carry a company-issued cell phone and respond to all monitoring alarms triggered by security or fire breaches in the system which may also include boiler failure or drops in water pressure to the facility. You would conduct internal investigations to diagnose and correct security-related trouble alarms and complete required inspections and testing, engaging external resources as needed.

As our ideal candidate, you would be known for being responsible, reliable, efficient and flexible. You would have a reputation for paying strong attention to detail and enjoy working as a team. You have basic computer skills and are familiar with barcoding systems. You are in good physical health and have talent with mechanical devices.
